

Tryouts for the 9U team will be scheduled at a later date in the spring. Any participant of Hi-point Baseball may try out for the team of their age group. All players' ages are determined by April 30, 2019. **Players must fill out the enclosed registration form and turn it in at the tryout.** Anyone not able to attend the tryout must contact the Parks and Recreation office at (937)592-3475 before 4:00 on Friday October 12th and inform office staff that they will not be able to attend the tryout. A coach will contact you to make up the missed tryout. In case of inclement weather tryouts will take place in the BHS Auxiliary Gym.

There is a financial obligation of each player that must be paid by March 1, 2019 to cover tournament costs. The cost will be determined by each coach based on fundraising and sponsorships for each team. This cost will not exceed \$100. The teams will compete in tournaments on weekends starting in April and ending in July. Tournaments are typically within 90 minutes of Bellefontaine with the possibility of one overnight trip each summer. Players/parents must be able to make time and weekend commitments to cover transportation for practices and tournaments. Practices will begin once a week at an indoor facility in February.
