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| <p><b>1</b> Park Entry<br/>- North side of SR 540, between SR 292 (to the East), &amp; CR 126 (to the West). Park open to the public sunrise to sunset, daily.</p> <p><b>2</b> Lodge &amp; nearby 'Tulip Poplar' Shelter House<br/>- Great venue for wedding receptions, business meetings, family reunions, etc.</p> <p><b>3</b> 'Troop House'<br/>- Large open building with restrooms &amp; kitchen, available for meetings, reunions, and overnights.</p> <p><b>4</b> 'Log Cabin'<br/>- 1800's era Log Cabin located near Myeerah Pond</p> <p><b>5</b> 'Maple' Shelter House Area</p> <p><b>6</b> 'Walnut' Shelter House &amp; 'Platforms' Camping Area</p> <p><b>7</b> 'Hickory' Shelter House &amp; 'Tree Houses' Camping Area</p> <p><b>8</b> 'Lake' Shelter House &amp; MacDonnell Lake</p> | <p><b>9</b> 'Willow' Shelter House &amp; 'GS' Wetland Area</p> <p><b>10</b> Girl Scout Wetland, Developed to ensure water quality of MacDonnell Lake. An elevated boardwalk runs through the wetland providing a unique opportunity to experience the habitat with minimal impact</p> <p><b>11</b> Headwaters Stream Branch of Mill Creek (Scioto River Watershed)</p> |
