ADMINISTRATION REPORTS:

Mayor – Held police interviews of seven (7) candidates. Met with Civil and Service this morning and they have certified that eligibility list. Also reviewed the fire fighter eligibility list. Both lists are healthy with great candidates waiting for the next opportunity.
 On Friday, the Chamber of Commerce found out that \$500,000.00 will be coming through from the state to Logan County so that small fifty (50) small businesses, meeting certain criteria, can apply for up to \$10,000.00 grants. Received notification this afternoon, from the Utility Department, that Bridges Community Action also released news of a sizable grant to help citizens with their water bill, shut offs or with reconnect fees.
 Asks that President Wagner call for a straw vote to support/nominate/reappoint the three board members that have served on the Bellefontaine Port Authority to the new Bellefontaine-Logan County Finance Authority. Questions answered.

S/SD - Updates on projects include the completion of the paving project with 43 streets and alleyways paved. Zimmerman Paint will start the stripping as weather permits.
 The East Sandusky turn lane is under contract and water line work has begun. This project will continue through the winter. In June/July ODOT will pave East Sandusky.
 Shawnee Trace Road extension from Brown to Newford is complete and has made a nice wide street and will also make it easier access for Safety Services to reach that area.
 The Airport Apron project is complete and ready for FFA testing and approval.
 The city has purchased twelve (12) industrial black picnic tables for outdoor dining areas. Funds were expended from the COVID grants. Also six (6) additional trash containers were purchased.
