

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A PLAN AND MAP DIVIDING THE CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE INTO WARDS FOR VOTING PURPOSES AND AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO APPROVE SAME FOR PURPOSES OF THE LOGAN COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Bellefontaine, Ohio:

SECTION I: That the division of the City of Bellefontaine into wards pursuant to Section 731.06 of the Ohio Revised Code as is shown on the map attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit A**, is hereby adopted and approved and the ward lines of the City of Bellefontaine, Ohio shall hereafter be as shown on said map.

SECTION II: That pursuant to Section 731.06(B) of the Ohio Revised Code the Service-Safety Director be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to make such subdivisions of the City into wards in accordance with map attached hereto as Exhibit A and he shall report the same to the Logan County Board of Elections.

SECTION III: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure made necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of said City, and specifically to promote the public prosperity and general welfare of the City of Bellefontaine by allowing said new wards at the earliest possible time and it shall, therefore, be in force and take effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor, and for voting purposes, shall be effective for the first municipal primary election occurring at least one hundred fifty days after the passage of this ordinance pursuant to Section 731.06(F) of the Ohio Revised Code.

EXHIBIT A

Being a description for Annexation Purposes only, of part of the Star Holdings Trust 5.010 acre parcel of land as deeded and described in Official Record 1139, page 878 of the Logan County Records of Deeds and being more particularly described as follows :

Lying in Section 10, Township 3, Range 14, Harrison Township, Logan County, Ohio :

Beginning at a 1 inch iron bar found at the northwest corner of said Section 10 -

Thence, South $84^{\circ}15'00''$ East, along the north line of the northwest quarter of said Section 10 and the centerline of State Route 47, passing through a railroad spike found at 24.50 feet, a total distance of 75.00 feet to a Mag nail set -

Thence, South $05^{\circ}00'51''$ West, passing through a 5/8 inch iron bar set at 30.00 feet, a total distance of 170.00 feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar set -

Thence, North $84^{\circ}15'00''$ West, a distance of 75.00 feet to a point in the east line of a 32.957 acre parcel of land deeded to Clifford Eugene and Mary Jane Kelly by deed recorded at Official Record 111, page 219 and the west line of said Section 10, said point being referenced by a 5/8 inch iron bar set on the west line of said Section 10 and 5.00 feet south of corner -

Thence, North $05^{\circ}00'51''$ East, along the east line of said 32.957 acre parcel and the west line of said Section 10, passing through a 5/8 inch iron bar found at 140.00 feet, a total distance of 170.00 feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 0.293 acre of land more or less of which 0.051 acre lies within the State Route 47 right-of-way.

Subject to all easements and right-of-way of record.

The north line of the northwest quarter of said Section 10 (also centerline of State Route 47) was assumed to bear South $84^{\circ}15'00''$ East in agreement with a survey by George A. Blackburn, Professional Surveyor 7873, dated November 1, 2005 and is on file in the Logan County Engineer's Office.
